

When will I be coming back to Glengowan?

A letter was put on the school App on Monday 3rd of August for your parents, but here is a reminder. You will be returning in groups over the first 3 days. Wednesday 12th August - P1 only (9am not 10am) Thursday 13th August - P1-3 Friday 14th August - P4-7 Monday 17th August - Whole School

Usually we would invite Primary 1 to come at 10am on their first day, but we would like them to come at <u>9am this year.</u>

Where do I go on my first day? Which door and gate should I use?

For the first few days, all children will come in through the main front door.

<u>Wednesday</u>

On Wednesday, Primary 1 children should arrive at 9am. Mr Murray and Mrs Field will meet you at the front door. Adults can take photos of you outside the building, but cannot come inside.

An adult will tell your parents which gate you should be collected from at the end of the day.

<u>Thursday</u>

Primary 2 and 3 children should come inside from 8.45am onwards and meet their teachers in their new classrooms.

On Thursday, Primary 1 children should arrive at 9am and a member of staff will meet you. There will be a sign telling your parents which gate you will be using at the end of the day.

<u>Friday</u>

Primary 4-7 children should come inside from 8.45am onwards and meet their teachers in their new classrooms.

There will be a sign telling your parents which gate you will be using at the end of the day.

Am I allowed to bring a school bag?

Yes. You may also bring a pencil case with all the things you'll need. Unfortunately, you cannot share your pencils, coloured pencils, rubbers or pencil sharpeners with anyone else. We will have a supply of pencils and anything else you will need to do your classwork.

Everyone should also **bring a filled water bottle every day**. This should be taken out of your bag and put on your desk.

Do not bring any toys to school. This includes action figures, dolls, trading cards and skipping ropes.

Should I wear a school uniform?

Yes. Please wear your uniform. Your parents can find out about our uniform from the school handbook and our App. Trousers and skirts can be black or grey. We have lots of red sweatshirts and cardigans if you don't have one.

You won't be changing your shoes in the cloakroom when you come inside for just now. This may change and Mr Murray will let your parents know. You will be outside more than usual, so **please bring a jacket**.

Will lunchtime be different?

Some schools will have to have different lunchtimes because there isn't a lot of space. We will be using the canteen, the hall and the downstairs open area. We should have plenty of room for everyone to have lunch before 1pm. The tables will be spaced out and you will be sitting in class groups.

You can choose to have a packed lunch or a canteen lunch.

Will playtimes be different? What part of the playground will I be in?

Not yet. Hopefully, we will be able to offer some activities later in the year.





Will we still be washing our hands regularly?

Yes. We have new soap dispensers and hand sanitisers installed in the classrooms and corridors.



Does the school look different now?

Yes. There are signs on the walls reminding you to wash your hands regularly. Your teacher will explain all that you need to know about the other signs.
