Dear Parent/Carer

I have a number of new initiatives and news items to share with you. I will continue to make updates available via our school app.



We have invested in a subscription to Reading Planet. This online resource will give the children access to a wider range of texts. Parents/carers of our P1-4 children will be familiar with Glengowan's use of decodable texts as part of our approach to teaching reading and this resource provides over 100 new titles to complement this. However, the extensive library includes titles for the whole school. In total, we will have approximately 550 books available online.

Class teachers will assign books to groups and individual children.

All of the children will receive details about how to access Reading Planet at home over the next few weeks. Some classes have been given the log in details already. The classes and children I have already spoken to have been encouraged to let their teacher know about any difficulties with access.

As with all new initiatives, I expect that we will have some challenges. I ask for your understanding and hopefully we will have all children accessing Reading Planet by the middle of November.

Reading Challenge

We have registered to take part in a Reading Challenge. P4-7 children will keep a record of titles read through the use of a Reading Passport. Books read at home, online or in class can be included. P1-3 classes will keep a record in a slightly different format.



Nursery Class Update

At long last, our Nursery Class has opened. A huge amount of work has gone into preparing this new provision. It should be noted that our new Early Years' Workers have only been at Glengowan for just over 1 week. What they have managed to achieve is outstanding. The post of Team Leader has now been advertised and I hope to interview candidates soon. Mrs Inglis is our Nursery Teacher. She has now been joined by Mrs Whitelaw (Blue Group), Mrs Duncan/Miss Gardner (Red Group), Mrs Kane (Green Group) and Mrs Aitken (Yellow Group).

Our provision begins at 9.10am and ends at 3.10pm. Please be aware that the P1-7 children who travel by bus will leave via the hall doors. I ask that Nursery parent/carers do not gather too early at these doors, taking into account that a group of children need to have a clear path to the buses.
