- Pupils attend school for 190 days each school year.
- In a whole school year, there are 380 possible openings.
- Each school day is equivalent to 2 possible openings.
 - 1 whole school day off = 2 absences.

6 School days missed	97%	Good
7 School days missed	96%	On Target
9 School days missed	95%	Slight Concern
School days missed	93%	Concerns
20 School days missed	90%	Very Concerned
30 School days missed	85%	Serious Concerns
