The use of mobile phones is not permitted during the school day. Please speak to your child about appropriate use of devices such as apple watches (or any other manufacturer) that could cause distraction in the classroom. As a school, we are keen that we limit the use of anything that may cause learning to be disrupted.

<u>Attendance</u>

Following our success in improving punctuality, there will be a focus on improving attendance. Due to illness and factors beyond our control, it would be unrealistic to have all of our pupils with an attendance rate of 100%. However, rather than waiting until the end of June, I will be contacting parents of pupils who have an attendance rate of below 80%. The main reason for this is to keep you up to date. We are able to provide a summary showing the reasons for your child's absences as recorded on our system.

Playground Improvements

Our Pupil Council made a request that more basketball stands be added to our playground. Through the support of the Glengowan Parent Group we have now taken delivery of the first two of these. The children in Primary 4-7 have already started making use of them. A similar, but lower, piece of equipment will be ordered for the younger pupils. A huge thank you to our Parent Group for acting on the request of our Pupil Council.
