As part of the Planning Approval for the Larkhall Community Growth Area, developer's contributions have been agreed to provide a school and nursery building extension at Glengowan. This is currently programmed to be completed for August 2022 and detailed design is scheduled to commence in 2020. In the meantime, it is proposed to create a 48 place nursery for January, 2020 by utilising two classrooms on the ground floor.
